If you are like most people you love to hear Good news!

Bad news is very depressing but good news brings encouragement and hope which warms the heart, and stirs up the emotion of Love.

Good news shines out in luster when contrasted to bad, so we will look at the sad story of the bad news, then present the BEST news you will ever hear!

We will examine the story of the beginning of the world, and the only source of this information is the Bible.

The Beginning

The first book of the Bible is called Genesis which means Beginning or Origin.

This is the record of the beginning of the world and how things began. God created a perfect world with perfect people, “*And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, it was very good...*” (Gen 1:31)

Jesus says, “*...there is none good but one, that is God...*” (Matt 19:17) So when the Bible declares everything to be good it means God was in everything, including Man.

So man was good because God was in him.

God created one life and out of that one life every human being received life, even Eve came from the one life God created when he made Adam. (Gen 2:7)

The life that was in Adam was perfect and good and so all of Adams children and children’s children would be given this perfect good life BUT, Adam chose to serve a different master and thus lost the life that made him good.

Bad News

“*Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned.*” (Rom 5:12)

This verse shows us that one man Adam by choosing to obey someone other than God lost the life of God and became imperfect immediately. This one act made him a sinner, one separated from God.

Since God is life, then without God there is no life, so death is the result.

Now the life that Adam possesses is a life without God, a life of sin which results in death and this is the life that Adam now passes on to his children and their posterity.

"...and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned."

When did all men sin? All men sinned or were separated from God when Adam sinned.

That means the life of Adam got corrupted and it was this corrupt life that has been passed on to every generation of men including you and me. (Acts 17:26)

We were born separated from God or sinners in need of a savior.

The Problem

Because of the nature that man was born with, he is unable to choose good. (Rom 8:7-8)

This places man in a great dilemma, so this beautiful passage is recorded for this reason. *"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."* (John 3:16)

The Solution

The plan to redeem man was simply based on God's Love for him, so God found a different father for mankind, one whose life is completely perfect and good.

This father would choose good and then pass this good and perfect life on to his children as a gift, and this gift is Jesus himself.

"And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son." (1John 5:11)

To receive the carnal corrupt life all that we needed to do was to be born; the life we receive at our birth makes us who we are, humans, separated from God – Sinners.

God's plan is to bring us back into union with himself by giving us his life thus redeeming us from Sin.

"For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead."

"For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive."
(1Cor 15:21-22)

How are we in Adam?

God made ONE life and that was Adam's life. Every other human being received the same life of Adam, even EVE. (Gen 2:21-23)
This life has been multiplied to billions of humans including you and me. By having his life in me, I am in him and his life works death in me.

How do I receive the life of Christ?

The converse is true about being in Christ. When Christ's life is in me, by the same means I am in him.

We can only have one life at any given time, so we either have Adam's life or Christ life.

If Christ lives, then Adam is death and vice versa.

For Christ to live, I must die, *"I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me."* (Gal 2:20)

Death to self is the prerequisite for receiving the life in Christ.

Then believing in our death and accepting it is where faith comes in.

"For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus." (Gal 3:26)

All that we are is already in Christ, and as we believe in who we are, and what we are, we are made in the same image.

"For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God." (Eph 2:8)

We receive the life of Christ by accepting the gift of God, the life of his Son, which he has freely given to all mankind, but we need to receive it, for it to become our experience.

Receiving then is the hand of faith that believes.

What are the Benefits of this new FREE life?

"Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new." (2Cor 5:17)

Your entire life is new proven by your works. (Eph 2:10)

"That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;
